

COMMISSION EN BANC RESOLUTION NO. Series of 2018

"A RESOLUTION ON THE MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF LIONHEART FARMS PHILIPPINES CORPORATION (NOW LIONHEART AGROTECH) AND LETTER FOR RECONSIDERATION OF GREEN POWER PALAWAN AGRICULTURAL CORPORATION (GPPAC) IN THE MATTER OF THE COMMISSION EN BANC'S RESOLUTION NO.07-01-2017 DATED JANUARY 10, 2017"

WHEREAS, Lionheart GPAC Farms Corporation and Green Power Palawan Agricultural Corporation (GPPAC), entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Pala'wan ICCs of Barangay Ransang, Candawaga and Culasian, Municipality of Rizal, Palawan covering the utilization of 10,000 hectares of prime land that will host a project known as "Massive Plantation of Coconut and other Agricultural Crops";

WHEREAS, the MOA was reached after the community leaders/elders gave their Free and Prior Informed Consent (FPIC) pursuant to Section 24 of the 2012 FPIC Guidelines or the rule that governs the conduct of FPIC on non-extractive/small scale projects;

WHEREAS, consequently, Certificate Precondition (CP) with control number CP RIV-PAL-2016-02-03 was issued thereon in favour of the PROPONENTS Lionheart GPAC Farms Corporation and GPPAC;

WHEREAS, in the Commission en Banc (CEB) deliberation held on August 10, 2016, it was one of the findings of the CEB that there was improper application of Section 24 of the FPIC Guidelines considering that the project is within the category of Section 19 or the rule requiring full blown FPIC process;

WHEREAS, as a result of such findings, the CEB resolved to suspend the implementation of the MOA, through CEB Resolution No.07-01-2017, in order to institute corrective measures and to ensure that the FPIC of the members of the affected communities are secured in accordance with sections 19-23 of the 2012 FPIC Guidelines;

WHEREAS, a Motion for Reconsideration was filed by Lionheart Farms Philippines Corporation on June 1, 2017 and a letter for reconsideration, dated June 16, 2017, was likewise filed by Green Power Palawan Agricultural Corporation (GPPAC);

WHEREAS, in its Motion for Reconsideration, Lionheart Farms Philippines Corporation prayed of the CEB:

To recall its Resolution No.07-01-207 dated January 10, 2017;

2. To delete its order of the suspension of both the implementation of the MOA and the operationalization of the CP, and in lieu thereof, to issue an order affirming or restoring their efficacy; and

3. To afford Lionheart Farms Philippines Corporation the right to be heard if it insists that the project is large-scale and/or require Lionheart Farms

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Philippines Corporation to undertake the payment of bond as will be agreed upon with the Pala'wan Tribe pursuant to Section 23 and to submit the Environmental and Socio-Cultural Impact Statement pursuant to Section 21, and such other undertakings and documentary requirements as the NCIP may deem necessary for the protection of the welfare of the Pala'wan Tribal people.

WHEREFORE, on motion seconded, be it:

RESOLVED, that:

A. The FIRST and SECOND prayers are DENIED, to wit:

1. To recall CEB Resolution No.07-01-207 dated January 10, 2017;

 To delete the order of the suspension of both the implementation of the MOA and the operationalization of the CP, and in lieu thereof, to issue an order affirming or restoring their efficacy; and

B. The THIRD prayer is **GRANTED WITH MODIFICATION**, such that PROPONENTS, Lionheart and GPPAC, are required:

- a. To undertake the payment of bond Pursuant to Section 23 of the 2012 FPIC Guidelines;
- To submit the Environmental and Socio-Cultural Impact Statement pursuant to Section 21 of the 2012 FPIC Guidelines;

 To submit a comprehensive work plan which shall include its project profile and plan of operations;

d. To identify the actual areas of operations within the applied area; and

e. To comply and observe the procedures and submit necessary documents pursuant to Sections 19-23 of the 2012 FPIC Guidelines with the above documents fully explained to all concerned members of the community.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Order of Suspension contained in CEB Resolution No. 07-01-2017 **STANDS** until full compliance of the undertakings in the immediately preceding paragraph.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, as the composite team discovered during its conduct of field investigation on August 16-18, 2017 that there is an existing virgin coconut oil (VCO) processing plant within the applied area of the issued CP which was not disclosed in the FPIC process, the CP issued is therefore flawed. It is thus ordered that the FPIC process pursuant to "B.e" of the above incorporate such activity. In consequence thereof, the operations of the VCO processing plant is hereby held in abeyance until full compliance of "B.a to e." of above.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Resolution to the NCIP R-IV, PROPONENTS Lionheart GPAC Farms Corporation and GPPAC, and other stakeholders.
